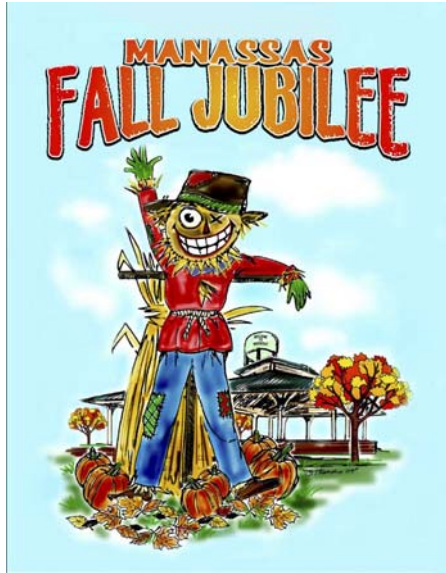

VA Releases IG Report

The Department of Veterans' Affairs Inspector General's office released their final report after months of investigating wrongdoing at the Phoenix Hospital system. The investigation reviewed the care of over 3,400 patients and included interviews with 79 employees. Issues identified poor quality of care and inappropriate scheduling practices which were shown to be systemic nationwide.

It also concluded that VHA missed opportunities to hold senior and field faculty leadership responsible and accountable for implementing proper action and compliance standards with regards to scheduling procedures. VA Launches Updated GI Bill Comparison Tool

This week VA launched a new version of its GI Bill Comparison Tool, with new features that will allow veterans to estimate the actual cost of attendance for potential schools and compare new veteran-specific school characteristics, such as whether or not a school offers an organized student veteran group. Your VFW played a key role in commissioning the GI Bill Comparison Tool earlier this year, and VFW advocates also worked closely with VA on the improvements rolled out earlier this
